

Cambridge International May/June 2023 Registration process:

Thank you for contacting the British Council, regarding Cambridge International.

Register for your Cambridge International exam

You must register online here: <https://schoolexams.britishcouncil.org/#/select-country/>.

***Tips to assist with the registration page:**

- Sign up first
- For each subject you select please add to the basket before you select a new subject.
- When looking for AS level subjects under Qualification Level and it is not available please also check for the subject/s under A Level.
- One email address registers only 5 candidates, please ensure that you use a different email address for every five candidates you register.
- As a Minor (younger than 18 years old) you are not able to log into the portal. Please ask your Parent/Guardian to create an account if you wish to create a new registration. On who are you booking the test for please Select *Child* then complete the form accordingly using the child's details.
- If you are over 18 years please complete your own registration.
- Please review your online registration before submitting as the British Council will not be responsible for what subjects/options code candidates register for. Candidates are held responsible for the subject they choose to register.

The registrations close on 15 February 2023, thereafter late fees will apply.

Pay for your exam

You will find the fees for all exams listed on the registration system. Your application will not be processed until you have paid for your exams in full.

Similarly, you will not be allowed to attend an exam if you have paid but have not completed the application and submitted this along with all required documents to the British Council for confirmation of your registration.
